Hereby authorizes Trade Expeditors USA Incorporated DBA TEU Global to act for and on its behalf as a true and lawful agent of the Foreign Principal Party in Interest (FPPI) for, and in the name, place and stead of the FPPI, from this date, either in writing, electronically, or by other authorized means to:

Act as Forwarding Agent for Export Control, U.S. Census Bureau (Census Bureau) reporting, and U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) purposes. Also, to prepare and transmit any Electronic Export Information (EEI) or other documents or records required to be filed by the Census Bureau, CBP, the Bureau of Industry and Security, or any other U.S. Government agency, and perform any other act that may be required by law or regulation in connection with the exportation or transportation of any goods shipped or consigned by or the USPPI, and to receive or ship any goods on behalf of the F.P.P.I.

Notwithstanding any conflicting obligations set forth in Incoterms® 2010 Rules, the FPPI undertakes to determine any export license requirements, to obtain export license or other official authorization, and to carry out any customs formalities as required for the export of the goods.

The FPPI certifies that all statements and information contained in the documentation provided to the Authorized Agent relating to exportation will be true and correct. Furthermore, the FPPI understands that civil and criminal penalties may be imposed for making false or fraudulent statements or for the violation of any United States laws or regulations on exportation and agrees to be bound by all statements of said agent based upon information or documentation provided.

This power of attorney is to remain in full forces and effect until revocation in writing is duly given by the Foreign Principal Party in Interest and received by the Authorized Agent.
